

DATA PRIVACY AND COOKIE POLICY

This privacy policy outlines how we process your personal data when you use the website <https://share.schuetz.net> (called "Schuetz" in the following). It also explains the choices you have concerning your personal information („your rights") and how you can contact us.

I. WHO IS RESPONSIBLE AND HOW CAN I CONTACT THE DATA PROTECTION OFFICER?

II. YOUR RIGHTS

Each person using our website has the following rights:

- Right of access (Art. 15 DSGVO)
- Right to rectification of inaccurate data (Art. 16 DSGVO)
- Right to cancellation or the right to be "forgotten" (Art. 17 DSGVO)
- Right to limit the extent to which your personal data is processed (Art. 18 DSGVO)
- Right to data transferability (Art. 20 DSGVO).

You can at any time and without stating reasons object to your personal data being saved and used for advertising purposes, including the analysis of customer data for advertising purposes.

In addition, you also have a general right of objection (cf. Art. 21 (1) DSGVO). In this case, you must provide reasons why you are objecting to your data being processed. If you have permitted us to use your data, then you can revoke this consent at any time with effect for the future.

The easiest way to exercise these rights is to send an email to: datenschutz@schuetz.net or to the address given above. In addition, you have the right to complain to the data protection supervisory authority that is responsible for you.

III. HOW SCHUETZ USES YOUR DATA

In the following, we would like to give you an overview of how we ensure the protection of any personal data you share with us when you access our website, what kind of personal data we process for which purposes and to what extent.

1. Data that are created when you access our website – log files

Every time you access our website, general information is automatically collected. This information (server log files) includes the type of web browser, your operating system, the domain name of your Internet service provider and similar data. The IP address is also transmitted and used to provide the service you have requested. This information is technically necessary to ensure that we can deliver the content you have requested and is essential when using the internet.

All this log file data is anonymized or deleted by us immediately after the end of your session. The legal basis for data processing is Art. 6 Para. 1 S. 1 f) DSGVO.

2. Data you share when using our email service

Data traffic is generated every time you use the email service offered on this site, including the email address of the sender, email addresses of the recipients, the name and contact details of the sender as well as corresponding log files for sending and retrieving messages and files.

These data are stored for the duration that the transmitted data or messages are made available and are deleted subsequently.

The sender's contact details are passed on to the recipient for the purpose of further contact in order to send a password. The data will be transferred to a third country (outside the European Union or the European Economic Area) if the recipient of the message is based there.

The legal basis for this is § 96 TKG.

In addition, the log files generated in the course of use are stored for 14 days to ensure proper operations; after this period they are deleted. The legal basis for this is § 100 TKG.

3. Keeping your data safe

On our website, we take technical and organisational security precautions to protect all the personal data stored here against unauthorised access by third parties, accidental loss, damage or destruction and to enable secure data transfer.

Please note that due to the nature of the internet, unauthorised data access by third parties can always occur. It is therefore also your responsibility to protect your data against misuse, for instance by using encryption or other suitable means. Without appropriate protective measures, unencrypted data can be accessed and read by third parties, even if these data are sent via email.

4. Encrypted data transmission

This website uses SSL (Secure Socket Layer) encryption in conjunction with the highest level of encryption supported by your browser for security reasons and to protect the transmission of personal data, for example requests that you send to us as the site operator. As a rule, this is a 256-bit encryption. If your browser does not support 256-bit encryption, we use 128-bit v3 technology instead.

IV. OUR COOKIE POLICY

1. General information about the use of cookies

Our website uses so-called cookies. A cookie is a small file that can be placed on your device that allows us to recognise and remember you. It is sent to your browser and stored on your device. Cookies are used to make our website and our online service more user-friendly, more efficient and securer. We use two types of cookies: temporary cookies, which are automatically deleted when you close your browser (also called session cookies) and permanent cookies.

You can choose whether you want to allow cookies to be set or not by making the appropriate changes in your browser settings. In principle, you can choose between accepting all cookies, being advised when a cookie is being set, or rejecting all cookies. However, if you choose the last option, you may not be able to use all of the functions we offer on the website.

Cookies are used for different purposes: there are essential cookies and cookies that serve a specific purpose (collecting access data, advertising purposes).

2. Essential cookies on this website

We use session cookies on our websites; these are essential to provide you with services you have requested. These include cookies that enable us to recognize you while you visit the site in a single session. These session cookies contribute to the secure use of our services by enabling us to securely verify the email address provided.
