

FULLY OPERATIONAL: THE NEW SCHÜTZ VASITEX RECONDITIONING AND RECYCLING CENTER



SCHÜTZ VASITEX in Brazil is a pioneer in the circular economy for industrial packaging. The company in Bonsucesso-Guarulhos near São Paulo has now renewed and expanded its existing reconditioning capabilities for industrial packaging. In recent months, thanks to an extensive investment programme, the area of the reco factory has been doubled and internal logistics have been further optimised, including the collection of packaging recovered through the SCHÜTZ TICKET SERVICE, the production of high-quality HDPE recycle, the reprocessing of the IBC steel grids and base plates, the production of the new inner bottles and the loading of the reconditioned containers.

Like all our factories, SCHÜTZ VASITEX meets the highest environmental standards.

A line for the production of F1 RECO tight-head drums is also located on the site. This drum type is made with 100 percent factory recycled materials, which SCHÜTZ VASITEX sources from used PE packaging.

Like all our factories, SCHÜTZ VASITEX meets the highest environmental standards and consistently follows international environmental, safety and quality management guidelines. The company is certified according to ISO 14001 and OHSAS 18001. It is the first and only company in Brazil to be authorised by the environmental authorities to recycle unrinsed, contaminated agrochemical packaging.
