THOUSANDS OF IBCS IN USE

SUPPORTING PEOPLE IN THE DISASTER AREA: SCHÜTZ PROVIDES MORE THAN 1,000 IBCS FREE OF CHARGE

The floods have caused massive destruction in Germany: Hundreds of buildings were torn away, thousands are homeless. According to evaluations of satellite images, almost 200 hectares of land were flooded along the Ahr alone. The insurance industry estimates the total damage incurred to date at around five billion euros.

In addition to accommodation, clothing and hygiene articles for daily needs, those affected urgently need clean drinking water in order to avoid diarrhoea, fever and infectious diseases. The force of the water masses has completely destroyed many pipelines. This is where our SCHÜTZ IBCs come into play: We have already

made over 1,000 containers available free of charge to the Technical Aid Organization, fire departments, and the German Army. They serve as storage containers for drinking water in the crisis areas and are used, among other things, as efficient mobile water treatment plants.
