SCHÜTZ IBÉRICA opens a new site in Cazalegas

Short distances, local service and a direct line of communication with the customer: as part of our drive to deliver these benefits, SCHÜTZ IBÉRICA has opened another site for IBC production and reconditioning in Cazalegas, Spain.



The new site is conveniently located in the immediate vicinity of Talavera de la Reina in the west of the province of Toledo. The plant, situated around 100 km from Madrid, is our second production facility for packaging systems in Spain alongside Vila-seca. The opening at the beginning of November is another important step that sees us expanding our market position in this steadily growing economic region. In future, customers from Spain and Portugal will be able to source SCHÜTZ's entire packaging range from Cazalegas.





A 9,000 m² production building is located on the approximately 27,000 m² site in Cazalegas. The latest technology and energy-efficient processes are central components of the plant layout, which has been meticulously planned for efficiency. The new site allows SCHÜTZ to meet the highest production and safety requirements for the production of IBCs – especially with regard to cleanliness and risk minimization. Like all SCHÜTZ sites worldwide, the new production facility in Spain has been certified in accordance with FSSC 22000 (Food Safety System Certification).

In Cazalegas, SCHÜTZ will be producing a wide range of IBC models, and preparations are already being made for the production of packaging from the eco-friendly GREEN LAYER product range. The new production building also houses a high-tech reconditioning line for the environmentally friendly recycling of used containers, which are collected by the SCHÜTZ TICKET SERVICE (STS) after emptying.

For the delivery of new containers and the collection of emptied IBCs, being close to our customers facilitates short transport routes and fast response times. This enables us to optimize the supply chain of our many customers in the region, both economically and environmentally.
