Cleancert and Foodcert jerrycans protect sensitive filling products along the supply chain

With its SC1 jerrycans in the Foodcert and Cleancert versions, Schütz offers packaging solutions in accordance with FSSC 22000, thereby guaranteeing maximum safety for sensitive filling products. While the Foodcert variant was developed specifically for the high requirements of the food industry, Cleancert is aligned towards applications with particularly stringent purity requirements. At FACHPACK 2025 in Nuremberg, Schütz will be presenting the expansion of its jerrycan series for demanding applications to a broad specialist audience.

Thanks to the use of modern 3-layer technology, Schütz SC1 jerrycans stand for high quality, stability, and versatility. And now these tried-and-tested plastic containers are also available as a Foodcert variant. The basis for food-safe packaging is the GFSI-recognised system certification according to FSSC 22000, which covers not only the end product, but also all materials used and the entire production process.

For manufacturers of food and other sensitive filling goods, this means maximum safety in processing and along the entire supply chain. Tested materials, strictly controlled production, and certified end products ensure the highest level of quality and reliably protect the integrity of sensitive contents. With this high manufacturing standard, Schütz offers customers in the food industry a cost-effective packaging solution that meets the increasing demands for product safety.

The SC1 series is also available in a Cleancert version, which is also based on the FSSC 22000 requirements. As it minimises the risk of contamination through preventive measures, Cleancert packaging is primarily used in industries where technical cleanliness plays a crucial role. This also makes it suitable for safe use in applications in the automotive industry, among others.

Schütz jerrycans are available in three colours – blue, white and natural – and in six sizes. All variants have UN approval, thereby offering maximum versatility for a wide variety of applications.
